Since the acquisition 10 years ago, the property has been meticulously restored its original glamour and added cutting edge technology.

In 2009, the Bently Reserve was the first event and conference center in California to receive silver certification in the National Leadership in Energy and Environmental Green Building Design Rating System for Core and Shell Development (LEED Silver CS). Today it remains one of San Francisco's most stunning venues and is featured on the National Register of Historic Places.
